Academic Regalia and Symbols

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The cap, gown, and hood have been worn by scholars since the Middle Ages. The academic costume was worn as regular dress by scholars, distinguishing them from other citizens; more practically, it kept them warm in unheated classrooms.

The American Intercollegiate Commission standardized the gowns and hoods in 1894. All robes were to be black. Bachelor's gowns had pointed sleeves; master's gowns, closed sleeves; and doctoral gowns, longer sleeves with three black velvet bands and with black velvet facing from hem to neck. Recently, some institutions have returned to distinctive gown color and design.

Lengths of hoods vary with the degree, the longest being for the doctoral degree. The lining of the hood reflects the institution's colors; The College of New Jersey's hood lining is gold. The colors of the hood facing represent various disciplines: for example, light brown, business; light blue, education; yellow, science; apricot, nursing; orange, engineering; and white, arts. The various colors are easily seen in the faculty and graduate students' processions.

THE MACE

The mace, once a weapon of war, became a ceremonial standard in the 16th century.

The College of New Jersey's mace, designed by Dr. Robert C. Burns, is crafted out of wood from a piece of furniture used at the original Trenton State Normal School on Clinton Avenue. The names of principals and presidents are set into the shaft.

On the surface of the shaft are panels depicting teacher and child, the symbol of the preparation of teachers; scientists, the symbol of intellectual activity; and athletes, the symbol of health. The mace, carried by the grand marshal in the academic procession, symbolizes the authority of TCNI's Office of the President.

THE MEDALLION

The medallion worn by the president displays the college seal, a reflection of TCNJ's history and tradition.

Adopted in 2014, this seal features the lion, the campus symbol since the 1920s; two books, representing the dual focus on the liberal arts and professional education; the sun, symbolizing the light of knowledge; and three stars in honor of the state of New Jersey, the third state to join the Union.

President Michael A. Bernstein received the medallion, a gift from the TCNJ Alumni Association, at his inauguration on September 27, 2024.
